In the reference second cited, Government have issued detailed guidelines called "Tamil Nadu Road Safety Fund Rules" for the administration of the fund.

2) Government have allotted a sum of **Rs.65/- Crores** under the Road Safety Fund for the financial year **2012 - 2013**.

3) In the reference 4th cited the Government has ordered that a High Level Team constituting of six members to monitor and implement the road safety engineering works like widening of narrow culverts and improvement of black spots by the revenue derived from the road safety tax.

4) Accordingly, in the reference fifth cited, the Chief Engineer, Highways (Construction and Maintenance) has sent a comprehensive proposal to the tune of Rs.12.34 Crores towards erection of Signal, provision of speed breaker, lighting facilities and sign boards at identified places in 24 districts.

5) During the 6th meeting of Road Safety Tax Revenue Monitoring Committee held on 22/03/2013, the Committee has considered the proposal of Chief Engineer Highways (Construction and Maintenance) and approved for release of funds to the tune of **Rs.12.34 Crores** towards road safety engineering works like erection of Signal, provision of speed breaker, lighting facilities and sign boards at identified places in 24 districts.

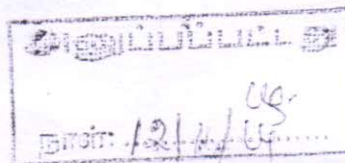
