ROAD SAFETY ACTION PLAN FOR THE YEAR 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020.

- The State is following Road Safety system approach with 5E model i.e. Engine (Transport), Engineering (Roads), Enforcement (Police), Emergency care (Trauma centres / Ambulances) and Education (Awareness).
- The Hon'ble Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety has issued various directions to promote Road Safety measures and reduce road accidents and fatalities in the State.
- Every month the District Collector will convene the District Road Safety Committee meeting to analyze and monitor the road accident prone areas and suggest rectification works to be carried out by the district level officials.
- Convening of State Road Safety Council meeting to advice the Government on Road Safety related program and review the safety measures of all stakeholder departments (Police, Health, Highways, School Education, Municipal Administration, Corporation, Town Panchayat).
- Annual Target (for the year 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020) has been fixed on monthly basis to every District Collector to reduce the road accidents and fatalities in each district, so as to achieve the reduction of fatalities to 50% by considering 2016 as base year.
- The monthly target fixed to each district has been analyzed so as to identify the number of districts achieved the actual target fixed to them
- The district wise road accident, fatalities, number of persons grievously injured, Minor Injured data for every month has been analyzed throughout the year.
- Comparison of road accidents and fatalities data during the month of the current year and previous year has been analyzed.
- Analyze of accidents and deaths according to types of vehicles, roads and other causes. Analysis of death due to Non-wearing of Helmet.
- Road Safety Corners were created in the Two-Wheeler show rooms for imparting and brief about the Road Safety aspects to every buyer of Two-Wheeler, before delivering.
- The Tamil Nadu Accident Emergency care Initiatives (TAEI) is to ensure definitive treatment for the injured within the Golden Hour.

- All the Regional Transport offices, Road Safety Training Centers (RSTC) were established to create awareness among public who visiting to RTO office for Learner License, Registration of vehicle, new Driving License and Renewal of Driving License.
- Similarly, all Traffic Police stations are designated as "Traffic Training Centers".
- Broadcasting of Road Safety Jingles through All India Radio and Private FM channels in Urban and Corporation areas.
- Highways department engages in creating and improving the road infrastructures completed the Road Safety Audit in all the State Highways, Major District Roads and Other District Roads of Highways Department.
- Removal of encroachment in the pedestrian's lane and walking way in Highways road of Local bodies.
- Provide Blinker with Speed Limit in accident prone Junction, curves, settlement in National Highways, State Highways and other roads. The Highway Patrolling vehicles of the Police Department are being stationed on the stretches of National and State High ways with distance of 50 Km each to remove unauthorized parking of vehicles.
- Avasaram App (with Automatic GPS location fetching of accident sites) and Pilot app based on the GIS mapping helps to contact emergency care and to guide the ambulances to the Trauma care centers.
- Formation of Road Safety Club with the objectives of making school children as messenger of society at large on road safety and educate them about safe road, safe speed, safe drive and safe vehicle.
- Inculcating road safety to young minds of children, subject on Road Safety has been included in the School curriculum from standard 1 to standard 12 during the year 2018-19,2019-20,2020-21.
- Presentation of Underage driving of students in Schools and driving/riding of students without Driving License in Colleges
- Awareness campaign about road accidents, organizing of camps in colleges and Rural areas for issuing LLR.
